

Evelyn Mo, pianist



At age 18, Evelyn Mo is currently a freshman at Harvard University. She has studied with John O'Connor for the past three years. Most recently, she was a prizewinner in the 2016 New York International Piano Competition, the 2016 PianoArts North American Competition, and the inaugural Cliburn Junior International Competition.

Evelyn won first prize in the 2013 Theodor Leschetizky Concerto Competition for Gifted Young Pianists, and has also won first prizes at the 2014 David D. Dubois Competition, 2013 Lee University International Competition, and 2012 Blount-Slawson Young Artist Competition. She was named a 2015 National YoungArts Winner and was a scholarship recipient from the Chopin Foundation of the United States.

Evelyn has performed with the Montgomery Symphony Orchestra, Orchestra of Northern New York, Camerata New York, the Shenandoah Symphony Orchestra, and the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra. She has performed at Carnegie Hall, Merkin Hall, and the Kennedy Center, and has appeared on WQXR's 'Piano Prodigies' show and NPR's 'From the Top.'

Evelyn also plays the violin, and was co-concertmaster of the American Youth Philharmonic. She is a member of the Harvard-Radcliffe Orchestra.
